Dear Parent / Guardian:

MBBS III classes will begin immediately after the last Viva/Practical for the MBBS 2<sup>nd</sup> Professional Annual 2015 examination to be conducted by the University of Karachi. Dates for these examinations have not yet been announced by KU. There has been an unfortunate delay in the examinations this year due to court cases initiated by individual students from various colleges affiliated with the University of Karachi. The court has restrained University of Karachi from conducting any examinations for MBBS/BDS until the court cases have been resolved.

All students enrolled in MBBS Second Year 2014 who passed their 1<sup>st</sup> Professional Examination 2014 will be provisionally promoted to Third Year and will be required to attend Third Year classes in 2015. Those students who pass the MBBS 2<sup>nd</sup> Professional Annual or Supplementary 2015 Examination will be eligible to sit in Third Professional Examinations 2016 if they meet the following requirements:

- Minimum required attendance (75% in all lectures, tutorials, practicals and clinics),
- Pass all Third Year Clinical Wards
- Present in 2 Journal Clubs
- Clear all fees

Tuition fees for MBBS III are due. If full fees are deposited on or before **March 20, 2015**, a 5% discount will be allowed. Tax is calculated at 5% on the fees paid as per section 236I introduced by the Finance Act 2013 and is applicable to any late surcharge as well. The rate of tax may change in the future as per Government announcement.

All late payments (ie after May 4, 2015) are subject to late surcharges as follows:
